Airport Master Planning, Tancredo Neves International Airport, Brazil

CH2M HILL is providing an airport master plan for Tancredo Neves International Airport (TNIA), one of the fastest growing airports in Brazil. Updates to the airport's master plan are critical, given Brazil's growing economy and its status as host nation for the 2014 World Cup and 2016 Summer Olympics.

TNIA has significant long-term potential to become a major domestic and international airport for passengers, air cargo, aviation-related development, and non-aviation business growth.

The CH2M HILL team's scope includes an industrial development plan for TNIA, as well as an assessment of the potential for private investment at the airport. CH2M HILL is also incorporating the State of Minas Gerais' strategic long-term vision for TNIA into the airport master plan and non-aviation development plan.

The master plan project includes a 30-year airport development plan, including new runways, taxiways, passenger terminals, landside facilities, and commercial and industrial development. This planning project is being done in the context of the fastest growth in aviation demand in Brazil's history.

CH2M HILL's multi-disciplinary team is developing a master plan for TNIA which will include solutions for growth that can be cost-effectively financed and implemented, and can be attractive for private sector participation. Our airport planners and engineers are identifying and recommending projects to be implemented in phases, as justified by demand, resulting in projects that are affordable and implementable.

CH2M HILL is also providing a preliminary analysis of options for private sector participation, concessions, or other types of airport management structures that meet future needs and that are adaptable to accommodate the state's long-term vision for TNIA airport.
