Port of New Orleans Erato St. Cruise Terminal and Parking Garage

CH2M HILL was awarded the contract to provide engineering and architecture services and prepare contract documents for the construction of a multi-purpose cruise terminal with a multilevel parking garage on the Port's Erato Street Wharf.

The Port of New Orleans needed a new cruise terminal and integrated parking garage to capture the parking revenue of the drive-to cruise passengers, and to accommodate the 3,800 passenger cruise ship Conquest deployed by Carnival Cruise Lines. CH2M HILL provided planning, design, and construction management services for an approximately 90,000-square-foot cruise terminal and an integrated 1,100-car parking garage. This facility will integrate passenger vehicle circulation within the cruise terminal/parking garage structure, maximizing use of the limited space the site offers along the riverfront. Unique challenges of working on the river bank were addressed through a combination of local and national geotechnical and structural engineers.
