Mr. Quarendon has worked extensively in Asia, including overseeing a US\$110 million fast-track advanced water treatment plant in Singapore, a US\$210 million, 300-million litres per day water treatment facility in Bangkok, a US\$115 million concrete gravity structure for Shell Philippines, and a US\$198 million rail rehabilitation project for SRT Thailand.

Before joining CH2M HILL, Mr. Quarendon served as Corporate Projects Director for Thames Water Plc., where he was responsible for delivering major capital works projects worldwide, including an Ajman sewerage project in the United Arab Emirates and a US\$350 million advanced water treatment facility in Phoenix, Arizona.

Recently Mr. Quarendon served Thames Water as Chairman of the Design Build Joint Venture Board on the Stockton, California, water, wastewater and storm water project that involved major facility upgrades to bring discharges in line with new environmental consent orders.

Prior to this he was Group General Manager Commercial for John Holland Asia Ltd, based in their regional HQ in Malaysia and worked with subsidiary offices in Thailand, Vietnam, Singapore, Indonesia, the Philippines, Hong Kong, India, and Sri Lanka.
