Golden Ears Bridge Project

On March 3, 2006, the Golden Crossing Group achieved Financial Close with the Greater Vancouver Transportation Authority (TransLink) for the CDN \$900M Design Build Finance and Operate (DBFO) Golden Ears Bridge Project. The project includes a new crossing of the Fraser River, about 30 km east of Vancouver.

Led by Bilfinger Berger BoT, the key members of the Golden Crossing Group include CH2M HILL, in a fully integrated Design Build Joint Venture with Bilfinger Berger Civil. As it is an integrated joint venture, CH2M HILL will participate fully in the construction of the project.

The Golden Ears Bridge is a 968 m long steel, composite, extrados bridge crossing the Fraser River. The project also includes:

- 13.3 km of 2, 4 & 6 lane mainline
- 11.5 km of local street reconstruction
- 17 bridges with a total length of 4.656 km
- Project construction through four different municipalities
- Utility relocations for five different utilities
- Training and employment benefits to the Katzie First Nation

Project Status

Substantial completion will be in July 2009.
